

This bakery-cafe also offers Fast Lane Kiosks, in addition to cashier stations, so wait times are reduced. The kiosk is highly visual and includes a product builder to assist with order accuracy and customization. At the kiosks, and through the Panera web or mobile app, guests can save customizations, past orders, and "favorites" for easy ordering on their next visit. They can also redeem MyPanera rewards and securely save their credit card information for future quick checkouts.

For those on the go, an ordering option called Rapid Pick-Up will enable customers to place an online/mobile order from the office, car, work or home – up to two weeks in advance – and pick up food at a pre-determined time without waiting in line. The bakery-cafe will be equipped with a special "to go" pick-up area, featuring dedicated seating, an order-status monitor providing real-time information as orders are prepared and completed and shelf space to facilitate easy pick up.

"We live super close," said Ponte Vedra resident, Donna Vent. "We've known for six months that it's been opening. Living in Ponte Vedra we don't have a lot of places like Panera. Just quick food that is convenient and within walking, except for Starbucks."

# Golf legend Billy Maxwell celebrates 90 years at TPC Sawgrass

If there is one person who has earned a hole-in-one themed birthday cake, it's 90-year-old golf legend, Billy Maxwell. On July 22, he celebrated his ninth decade amidst fellow professional golf friends, family and a photo slide of all his career highlights at the TPC Sawgrass Country Club.

Maxwell even started the party off with a few putts on a model practice green to help him get warmed up.

It's amazing to think that it was 68 years ago when Maxwell won the U.S. Amateur title after helping North Texas State College win four consecutive NCAA Division team championships. Later he would go pro, winning seven times on the PGA Tour after serving time in the army. At his height, he won the Bob Hope Desert Classic while ranking in the top 25 in 24 stats, and nine of those were in top 10.

"There is only one U.S. Amateur, so it's a lot of golfers' dream today to win the Amateur," said daughter Melanie Bevill. "A lot of them say, 'I won the Masters but I would trade any one of those victories to say (I was a) a U.S. Amateur."

Originally from Abilene, Texas, Maxwell was practically raised on the green. His father was the superintendent of what is now known as the Maxwell

Municipal Golf Course, which was named after him. Billy Maxwell was one of three sons who were to all become professional golf players. He married Maxwell's mother after teaching her how to play.

"It's always been about golf," said Bevill, jokingly. "Really, at home I thought, could we ever talk about anything else?"

These days, however, Maxwell attends the American Golf Memories Project meetings so he can keep talking about golf — and is encouraged to do so. The nonprofit is hosted by Billy Dettlaff, who although retired, has sported a long career with the PGA Tour. He founded the first-ever American chapter of the program, which uses reminiscence therapy to help offset cognitive decline, such as memory loss, Alzheimer's and dementia.

"It's really lovely, they bring a group of golfers and they talk about some of their great memories involved," Bevill said. "He will talk about winning the Bob Hope and what he shot on and whatever. That's what's amazing about golfers, they remember all those kinds of details."

The day of his party Maxwell spent the morning attending a group meeting with the Golf Memories Project. He was in good spirits, identifying professional golfers from throughout history and smiling while talking about the game. As the party commenced, he greeted everyone as they came over and wished him a happy birthday. Bevill said he planned the next day, July 23, to go to Cracker Barrel on his actual birthday. He wore 90 proudly during his party, however.

"Usually if I had a birthday for him, he's been mad at me and didn't want me to have it," Bevill said. "This time he didn't give me any trouble. I'm thinking 90 was kind of a big deal."

# 21st century parking in the Nation's Oldest City

The main reasons locals cite for not venturing downtown St. Augustine are traffic and parking. Mobility is an ongoing issue that has no easy solution, but in December 2007, the City of St. Augustine launched a valuable initiative that provided discounted downtown parking fees for St. Johns County residents — the ParkNow Card.

To promote the cards, the first 500 City water customers received a free card (in lieu of the \$2.50 one-time charge) when they paid water bills in December 2009. As word spread, the cards gained in popularity. According to Tara Bennie, parking coordinator, about 40,000 cards have been sold, and since the card itself does not expire, many of those may still be active with available funds.

The ParkNow Card still gives St. Johns County residents access to reduced parking fees at City meters, pay stations and in the Historic Downtown Parking Facility, but a more convenient App for cell phones was launched in early February.

The card helped, but users wanted to be able to add funds remotely or online instead of going to the water department or one of the "charging stations" downtown. Another request was to locate City parking areas. With the ParkStAug app available for Apple or Android phones, users can pay for parking, receive alerts before a parking session expires and extend a parking session (within the limit) without having to return to the vehicle. Since the vehicle is identified by its license plate, a receipt is not required on the dashboard.

One of the most noticeable changes to downtown parking will be the removal of parking meters. Eliminating parking meters, a downtown fixture for nearly 75 years, is intended to reduce clutter and

Anne Crawford celebrates 10 years as Assistant Branch Manager and Youth Services Librarian at the Ponte Vedra Beach Branch — St. Johns County Public Library System where she enjoys working with kids and teens, inspiring them to love reading and libraries.

# Anne Crawford

### What can you share about your background?

I was born in Atlanta, and primarily raised from second grade in Norcross, Georgia by two wonderful parents, Bill and Cathy Snyder. My younger brother, Frank, is a foot taller than me with a super-deep voice, and we had a Siamese cat named Sammy, and later a Jack Russell Terrier named Skye. I had special needs: I was born partially deaf and attended the Atlanta Speech School until I was mainstreamed into public school in second grade. I also grappled with ADD after mainstreaming. While my home life was great, school was tough, particularly middle school and high school, due to bullying. All of this informed the person I am today and makes me that much more determined to help put more kindness into the world and encourage youth to do so as well.

### How did you choose Stetson University?

My parents were born and raised in Palatka, Florida, and every summer until I was 22, we vacationed at my parents' "hometown beach" – Crescent Beach on Anastasia Island – at the beach condo they still own. I knew, at some point, they would retire to this very beach, and since we are so close, I wanted to live near them if I could in the future. That's what initially made me consider Florida schools. I thought about Flagler, but as I was still a dedicated clarinetist, it didn't have performance opportunities, but Stetson did. I found out that my paternal grandfather got his bachelor's degree at Stetson, and once I visited the school, I fell in love.

### What inspired you to pursue library science at FSU?

I took a year off from school after Stetson to figure out what I wanted to do. Teaching wasn't quite the right fit for me, but through my work with the St. Augustine YMCA, I still knew my passion was working with children and, through the Storytimes I created in my work with the Y, firing up kids about reading. I was in charge of Kindergarteners and first graders in the after-school program at Hartley Elementary, and every day, they clamored for me to read "The Foot Boot" by Dr. Seuss after I read it a few times. When I noticed they could recite it without my saying a word, I decided to enter the whole group into the Y's Talent Contest being held after school. On stage, these kids (now 25 and 26 years old!), performed "The Foot Book," reciting the story and marching to the beat. They all won first place! I started thinking, what if I combine two of my passions – working with kids and reading? It turns out, as a Youth Services Librarian, I get to incorporate my third passion as well – music!

### When and where was your first position at a library?

As of July 28, 2019, I will have worked for St. Johns County Public Library System for 16 years (10 here at PVB as of October 5, 2019). Branch Manager Amy Ring and I helped open the Southeast Branch Library in 2003. I was Children's Librarian, and she was the Young Adult Librarian, both fresh out of graduate school. I was promoted in July 2007 to Assistant Branch Manager and Youth Services Librarian at the Anastasia Island Branch Library. I transferred to Ponte Vedra in October 2009.

### How have library services changed since then? How have they remained the same?

Technology has been a huge game changer for Libraries since 2003. Smart phones and streaming opportunities didn't exist, and the internet was still relatively young. Although our services and methods have adapted to evolve with these trends, our intent has not. We are still looking, with every interaction, to be helpful, to be accessible, and to be kind to each and every person we serve. More than ever, Libraries are community hubs that are helping to combat the distance all this technology creates, allowing for members of the community to share common interests, make friends and to simply feel accepted.

### Tell us about your position at the Ponte Vedra Library.

I've had the pleasure of working as the Assistant Branch Manager and Youth Services Librarian since I was a newlywed in 2009. Branch Manager Amy Ring's leadership inspires me every day. I also get to work with Maribeth Wood who puts her heart into everything, tremendous staff and Friends of the Ponte Vedra Beach Branch Library. But most of all, I get the absolute pleasure of working with our kids and teens, inspiring them to love reading and libraries, and giving them a safe place to be themselves.

### Kindle or traditional printed book?

Both! Whatever format gets you reading is a big thumbs up in my book – pun intended.

### What's your favorite thing about working in Ponte Vedra?

My favorite thing about working in Ponte Vedra is the people. So many folks still remember when I was pregnant eight years ago and ask me with smiles about my daughter. Ponte Vedra – like the neighborhood I grew up in Georgia – can get an unfair rap of being an affluent community considered to be comprised of people who are aloof and unaccepting of differences. Nothing could be further from the truth! The people who visit the library are warm, kind individuals from a variety of walks of life and are so supportive of our efforts to be as inclusive and welcoming as possible. That attitude – from our patrons to our staff to our VolunTeens – is what allows us to especially reach kids and teens who may feel marginalized elsewhere but are at home and free to be themselves at the Ponte Vedra Beach Branch Library.

make it easier for pedestrians, wheelchairs and strollers to get around. Parking pay stations will remain for anyone not using the ParkStAug app.

Back in 2009, the hourly metered rate was \$1.50, but those with a ParkNow Card paid 50 cents per hour at meters and just \$1 to enter the parking garage. Garage parking rates increased over time, but it's still affordable for County residents — \$3 to park in the garage and still 50 cents per hour at City meters. The on-street time limit is 3 hours; the parking lot time limit is 4 hours. Overnight parking is not allowed in the garage without a special permit.

The new app is not accepted in the parking garage. The only way to get the resident discount at the Historic Downtown Parking Facility is by using ParkNow Card, so the cards will remain in effect for the foreseeable future.

Download the ParkStAug app free from Google's Play Store or Apple's App Store to pay for parking in all city managed parking locations. The app is similar to others that facilitate online transactions. Once downloaded, the user enters a method of payment and the license plate number of the vehicle. Users can set up the app at home before going downtown to park.

St. Johns County residents can register for discounted fees at www.ParkStAug. com. Be prepared to upload images of your vehicle registration and driver's license.

According to Bennie, 868 St. Johns County residents have applied for and received the resident discount available on the ParkStAug app. Except during peak times, like weekends or holidays, the turnaround time for approval to receive the resident discount is within two days. Having the proper documentation when submitting the application expedites the process. A driver's license and vehicle registration with a St. Johns County address is required in order to get the residential discount. Those needing assistance may contact the Parking Division at (904) 845-1090.

Once registered, the resident discount rates will be automatic when paying to park using the app. When the vehicle is

parked, the user simply opens the app and selects the zone where the vehicle is located. The zone ID is displayed on signage in the area. Enter the desired amount of parking time, called a session, and with a quick click the user is legally parked. Users know the parking session has successfully started when the Parking Session screen with a session countdown and expiration time is displayed.

When the session is about to expire, the app sends an alert and time can be added to the session if so desired. There's no need to skip dessert or cut shopping time short because of having to hurry back to the vehicle to "feed the meter."

Parking is enforced Monday through Saturday from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., except on Cathedral Place and King Street where enforcement begins at 10 a.m. Parking is enforced every day in the lot for the Castillo de San Marcos National Monument. 

# Tips on hurricane disaster preparation

Residents of St. Johns County have experienced many storms throughout history and as hurricane season is underway, it's important to know the basics of preparation.

Here are some "before the storm" tips from SJCC Emergency Management that might make a big impact the next time a hurricane strikes.

### **Gather important information**

Along with contact information for family members and friends, be sure to include banking, insurance and medical contacts. Include additional numbers that are important in case the evacuation lasts for an extended period of time. Keep all contact information up to date in a small notebook for easy access should residents be ordered to evacuate.

Bring all documents that are difficult or impossible to replace. This includes,

- Driver's license/picture ID/stateissued ID
- Cash/credit cards/debit cards
- Important telephone numbers and emergency contacts
- Medical records

- Prescription information medication, dosage, refills
- Doctors' names and telephone numbers
- Insurance documents business, home, flood, vehicle including, policy numbers, policy types and household inventory; dvd, photo, video
- Banking/creditor information and contact numbers
- Documents adoption, death, divorce or marriage certificates; copies of wills; home, property, vehicle titles; passports

### **Emergency supply kit**

Ensure you and your family are prepared before a disaster strikes. If the community is impacted you may lose access to basic services, such as power and water. Access to essentials like food and water may be limited. Stock up on essentials and prepare. Here is a helpful list of all supplies that might come in handy.

■Water — One gallon per person per day for three to five days

# Small businesses need to be storm ready

Small businesses make up 99.8% of all businesses in Florida, according to the Small Business Administration. As an SBA/USDA Business Development Specialist for Florida Capital Bank, I work with small business owners throughout the state; I'm especially passionate about supporting the success of local small businesses right here in our community.

With hurricane season underway, now is the time to make sure your business is prepared to weather this

year's storms. The 2018 National Hurricane Center report revealed that Hurricane Michael, a category five storm, caused \$18.4 billion dollars of devastation in Florida — damage that impacted thousands of small businesses.

Along with encouraging all Ponte Vedra residents to be safe during this time, it's equally important to ensure small business owners are prepared and aware of the resources available to them in the event of a disaster. FEMA's Ready Business Hurricane Toolkit warns that 40% of small businesses affected by a natural disaster won't reopen. Often due to a lack of preparation.

It's never too early or late to begin preparing for an emergency. Here are a few ways to get your business ready:

### **SECURE INFORMATION AND DATA**

The first thing I advise is that you have a plan for securing important information. Your customers' informa-

tion and records are vital to the success of your business. Whether you have a cloud-based security system or a protected vault, it's important to make sure these documents and information are safe but also accessible. After a storm, remember that you may not have access to your place of business if there are damages. Keep that in mind as you implement plans for storing your data.

### **REVIEW INSURANCE COVERAGE**

There are two parts to insurance. The first is knowing the ins and outs of your coverage prior to a disaster. Check your insurance policy to make sure that there are no caveats. Review property insurance, flood insurance and business interruption coverage. The second part is having the information accessible in the event of an emergency. This includes not only your coverage and plan details, but also your agent's contact information. You'll want to quickly be able to contact your agent if you need to make repairs to your place of business, such as a leak in the roof or flooding. Have your insurance information handy because the sooner you can file a claim, the sooner you can return to normal operations.

### **CREATE A COMMUNICATIONS GAME PLAN**

Communicating to your customers during and after a disaster is important. Preparing this plan, in advance, is the key to being successful. Consider that you may have to close for several days. How can you effectively communicate that to your customers, employees and partners? There are several channels of communication to consider: email, text alerts, phone, website and social media. Whichever you decide is best for your business, have

a plan in place and keep the momentum going through constant updates.

### **KNOW YOUR SMALL BUSINESS RESOURCES**

In our community, the most valuable resource for small business owners is the Small Business Development Center at the University of North Florida. If you don't already have a local SBDC consultant, the center offers free consultations for small business owners. Through the SBDC at UNF, consultants can guide business owners through disaster relief offerings, including short-term lending options to aid with payroll and disaster-related costs. The worst thing that can happen to a small business is a shutoff of revenue. Without a constant flow of revenue, employees can't be paid, and the business can cease to function.

Not only is the SBDC at UNF a great resource for after a disaster, but even now, they have access to extensive information and resources that they want to share with small business owners. If your business needs help after a disaster, seek support. In 2018, the SBA approved nearly \$7 billion for disaster recovery loans. Find out more information by visiting sbdc.unf.edu.

### **LEARN FROM PAST MISTAKES**

My last piece of advice is to learn from past experiences. Hurricanes and storms are unfortunately very common in our state. Be aware of businesses in your area that may be similar to your business in size or industry and learn from their mistakes as well.

- Non-perishable foods/manual can opener
- Specialty Items such as baby food, formula and diapers for infants; Depends for the elderly; specialty foods for diabetic diets should also be included.
  - Prescriptions/medications
  - Clothing, including rain gear and sturdy shoes
  - First aid kit
  - Sanitation supplies wipes, garbage bags
  - Personal hygiene items
  - Flashlights and extra batteries
  - Radio battery-operated or hand crank
- Electronics and chargers cellphones, tablets,
- Activities books, cards, games, toys
- Cash banks and ATMs may not be available
- Any additional items you or your family may need
- Pet supplies At least three to five-day supply.

### **Know your risk**

Residents of St. Johns County are evacuated by zone, so it is important you know your zone. Visit the St. Johns County Emergency Management website and click the "My Evacuation Zone" link, enter your address and Know Your Zone.

Hurricane evacuation zones define the areas that need to evacuate. Each zone is vulnerable to different levels of storm surge

- Along the Atlantic coastline are evacuation zones A, B, C, D and E.
- The coastal counties of Northeast Florida (Nassau, Duval, St. Johns and Flagler) have added an evacuation zone. Zone F.
  - Along the St. Johns River, Zone F represents a

separate hazard comprised of low areas, or areas subject to flooding under specific conditions. Zone F in St. Johns County includes the lower lying areas on the western edge of the county along the St. Johns River, including portions of Hastings, Flagler Estates, Picolata and Wards Creek.

To find your evacuation zone online, visit the SJC Emergency Management website www.sjcemergencymanagement.org

In addition to knowing your zone, it is important to note that the SJC Emergency Management also discontinued the re-entry program as of 2017. Evacuation re-entry

will now be accomplished through proof of residency in evacuated areas. Examples of proof of residency can be a driver's license, state identification card, utility bill or lease agreement.

In the past, re-entry tags were issued to residents and business owners east of the Intracoastal Waterway. Green tags were issued for residents and business owners were issued two orange tags per business. While the tags were not mandatory, the goal was to facilitate a smoother and quicker re-entry process, but the program was determined to be ineffective.




# Pool prep for hurricane season

Many of you are likely busy preparing to leave for the annual summer family vacation or perhaps you are back from vacation and are consumed with getting your kids ready to go back to school. Before you know it, we will hear weather reports of a storm that is forming out in the Atlantic and heading this way. After all, we are already close to two months into the 2019 hurricane season — if you can believe it.

The last thing any homeowner wants to contemplate right now is a potential hurricane, especially after families in Northeast Florida have had a rough past couple of seasons and some are still dealing with damage caused by Irma. Nevertheless, it is better to make your plan and ask the questions now, while things are calm, before the storm is a couple days away from landfall.

For better or worse, many pool owners have become proficient in hurricane preparedness thanks to Irma and Matthew. But for those who need a little advice, we thought it would be beneficial to review a few tips regarding how to prepare your pool for a hurricane. The challenge is each pool, deck space and yard are different. You may have commercialsized deck drain or great natural change in elevation that assists with drainage, or you may have minimal deck drainage or drains that are clogged with dirt and don't allow for much drainage at all. Each situation is unique and must be viewed as such but, hopefully, you can take a few tips and then adjust as needed based on your situation.

The first question pool builders are asked is, "Should I drain my pool or lower the water level at all?" The Florida Swimming Pool Association does not mince words when it comes to emptying your pool. They strongly advise for homeowners not to empty their pool. The reason being, if water is removed from the pool, and the heavy rains from the storm raise the water table in your area, you may walk outside after the storm to find the structure of your pool floating in your yard. Because you removed the weight of the water, which was holding the pool shell down, the pressure from the water table under the pool becomes forceful enough to push the structure out of the ground causing all sorts of other

The most common follow-up question we get is, "Should I drain the water level inside the pool at all?" The answer varies greatly depending on each situation. If the surrounding deck has enough drainage and the water from the deck and house gutters properly drains into the yard, lowering the level in the pool may not be necessary. If you are concerned with the pool overflowing and the drainage not keeping up, you can lower the

level of water in the pool —but you are opening yourself up to other risks.

The FSPA recommends not to lower the pool more than 1 foot for a typical pool with standard depths. Draining the pool too much increases the chance the pool will float with ground saturation. The other requirements for draining the pool below the waterline tile are to shut off the valve and close off the skimmer. If water does not flow into the skimmer while the pump is running, the pump will run dry and burn up causing potential serious issues. Other pool owners choose to drain the pool to the bottom of the waterline tile but leave it high enough so that water is still getting inside their skimmer to prevent any potential issues with the pump.

If you choose to drain your pool before the storm — and it's likely draining will be needed after the storm — there should be a hose bib on the pool equipment. Attach a garden hose and run it to the best place to drain water on your property, turn on the pump to run the system, open the hose bib and water will start draining from the pool. Keep an eye on the progress or set a timer to keep checking the level. Be careful not to get distracted and let the pool drain below the waterline.

Other preventative measures include adding chlorine to, even if you have a salt chlorinator, and circulating it as much as possible before shutting the equipment off. It is recommended to turn off all electric power to the pool equipment at the circuit breaker. If the setup has a gas heater, it is recommended to shut off the valve supplying gas in case the line is compromised during the storm. If you live in a low-lying area and are concerned with the equipment area flooding, it is possible to disconnect the pump and store it in a dry room. A flooded pump will likely need parts replaced. In most cases, pool owners opt to shut off the equipment and then wrap any exposed electrical equipment with a waterproof material.

The last general question often asked is, "Should I throw my pool furniture

into my pool?" It is ideal to move any loose furniture and objects that are usually in the pool area inside the garage or house. If that is not possible, place them gently inside the pool to prevent them from becoming projectiles in the storm. The downside is, the furniture could scrape and consequently damage the plaster finish. The other concern is the chemicals in the pool may cause damage to the furniture.

After the hurricane has passed, drain the pool as needed to its normal level. If there is a heavy amount of debris inside the pool, use a pole and net to manually remove the debris as needed so the pump and filter don't get clogged. Once the pool is clean, inspect all the electrical equipment and make sure all valves are in the proper position. If everything is dry and all connections appear to be intact, turn the power back on at the breaker and get the pump running. If you hear any strange noises or smell anything burning, shut the equipment off and call a professional. If the equipment runs normally, it is time to test the chemistry. It is ideal to stock up and store chemicals in a safe place before the storm so you can then shock the pool and add chemicals as needed. You may need to vacuum sand out of the pool and, depending on how much debris goes through the filter, you may need to replace filter elements after getting the pool back up and running. Monitor the system closely to ensure everything is operating properly.

Hopefully, Northeast Florida will have a quiet hurricane season in 2019. However, if a storm heads our way, if you don't feel comfortable doing some of the tips above in preparation or after the storm has passed, contact an FSPA-approved pool professional who will be able to assist you. Keep in mind however, in the days leading up to as well as the weeks after, professionals will be inundated with service calls.

Until the weather channel reports systems forming, use the remaining time this summer to enjoy your pool area with friends and family.

# Faith and Freedom Coalition gathers in Washington

Two thousand people with Faith and Freedom Coalition gathered in Washington recently to lay the groundwork for the next presidential election, and it was a wild and exciting party. From the opening speech by President Trump to the keynote speech by Vice President Pence, the theme was simple: Keep America Great.

Faith and Freedom Coalition was the brainchild of Dr. Ralph Reed and since its founding more than a decade ago, it has become one of the largest faith-based political movements in the nation with a membership greater than 1.8 million. Technically, it is not wedded to a particular party, but to a core set of values. While it is true its goals and values align with the conservative philosophy, it would be a mistake to dismiss it as merely another Republican brand.

The coalition's principles – including a pro-life agenda – are at the center of its meaning and purpose, as well as a belief in Judeo-Christian traditions. Throughout the conference these themes were driven home again and again by a series of well-known and influential speakers, including the Senators Ted Cruz and Rand Paul, Secretary of Housing and Urban Development, Dr. Ben Carson, Education Secretary, Betsey DeVos, former Education Secretary and former Drug Czar Bill Bennett and author and documentarian Dinesh D'Souza. Other notable luminaires included Candice Owens and Charles Kirk, founder of Turning Point USA.

The conference began on a Wednesday with President trump delivering a rousing speech to the packed house, and those in attendance said the popular president was at his best, praising the faith-based group for its enduring and steadfast support despite continuing strong opposition.

Speaking the day before he departed for Japan to attend the G20 Summit, the President highlighted his administration's promotion of traditional values. Trump claimed the "shameful" oppression of religious believers "ended" the day he took office.

"We're saying Merry Christmas again," Trump said.

He ended his speech promising to combat socialism and affirming his promises to work on behalf of the Religious Right.

"In America, we reject the failed socialist ideology of government domination. You'll

end up with another Venezuela right here, and it won't take very long. Our rights don't come from politicians, they come from the creator," Trump said.

He added, "Above all else we know this, in America we don't worship government. We worship God."

In describing the President's speech, Dr. Reed said, "On the key issue priorities of the faith community, President Trump has delivered on his promises, including the confirmation of two Supreme Court Justices and over 100 lower court judges, protecting the sanctity of unborn life, defending religious freedom, passing historic criminal justice reform and supporting the state of Israel."

The conference continued to inspire with attendees visiting Capitol Hill, where a succession of congressional leaders addressed the standing room only crowd at Faith and Freedom's "Town Hall." Addressing the crowd, Reed praised those who are "doing the Lord's work in the Devil's city."

Tennessee Senator Marsha Blackburn began session by addressing her list of top-10 things to do as a freshman senator. The list included priorities such as abortion, judicial confirmations, support for Israel, defending "free speech" on campuses, and challenging alleged anti-conservative "censorship" by tech companies.

Big tech was a theme throughout the session as several congressmen and senators addressed the need to reel in big tech and to hold them more accountable.

Some of the loudest cheers were saved for Senate Majority Leader Mitch McConnell, whom Reed introduced as a "total hero" for

blocking Senate consideration of President Obama's Supreme Court nomination of Judge Merrick Garland — and for successfully overseeing the Senate's approval of the President's judicial nominees.

McConnell said that about one-fourth of U.S. circuit judges serving on the bench today are Trump nominees confirmed by the Senate in the past two-and-a-half years. He also pointed out the importance of Trump's nominees being many years younger, on average, than Obama's nominees

McConnell also denounced socialism, saying the Democrats "want to turn us into something we've never been." Addressing the current group of Democratic presidential candidates, he added, "They're all talking about turning us into a socialist country — all of them."

There's no guarantee who will control the House, Senate, and White House after the next election, McConnell said, but he stated clearly, "If the U.S. Senate is the last place standing, none of this stuff will pass while I'm the majority leader."

Congressman Mark Meadows, chair of the Freedom Caucus in the House of Representatives, was another representative who addressed the group. Meadows couched his work in terms of spiritual warfare, asking people to pray for him and saying, "The battle is ongoing, and each and every day, the enemy makes himself known."

Sen. Mike Lee of Utah also spoke, saying he has become more appreciative of the Declaration of Independence. The Senator then Lee cited Alexis de Tocqueville's writing, saying that religion was the source of America's strength.

"What makes us great is the choice we make every day to follow our God," Lee said. Lee, a Mormon, received loud applause for offering his personal religious testimony about his faith.

The crowd also warmly received the

remarks Sen. James Lankford of Oklahoma, who described his decision to run for Congress as an act of obedience to God.

"I believe God called on me to run," he said. It certainly wasn't what I thought I was intended to do, and at first I resisted, he said.

Josh Hawley, a freshman senator from Missouri, credited Religious Right activists with putting Trump in office, and lavished praise on the President.

"What President Trump accomplished during his first two years in office is truly historic," he said. "And that is especially true for those of us who are devoted to protecting life and securing our religious liberty. We have never had a president in my lifetime who is this pro-life, this profamily, this pro-freedom, this pro-religious liberty."

Hawley also spoke of the importance of federal judges, saying he was focused on, "the fight against big tech and their attempt to shut us down, to censor us, to stop our voices, to write us right out of the public square."

At the end of the town hall session, Reed told the crowd that former Senator Sam Brownback, now the U.S. ambassador for religious freedom, had told him that he can't walk 20 feet in the White House or a Cabinet agency or on Capitol Hill "without running into somebody who is (a) a committed believer and (b) somebody I have worked with for at least 20 years in advancing our prop-family, pro-life agenda."

Next to President Trump's remarks, perhaps the most moving ones were those of keynote speaker Vice President Pence, who praised the work of the coalition and President Trump, and proudly declared, "America is back!"

The highlight of the final evening was the presentation of the Winston Churchill Lifetime Achievement Award to Former Education Secretary Bill Bennett. He extolled the assembled crowd to not merely complain about the things they believe are wrong around them, but to do something about it.



# New construction on the Intracoastal Waterway

The owner's change of plans will be a buyer's good fortune when it comes to this brand new home, designed to take advantage of this beautiful site spanning 100 feet fronting the Intracoastal Waterway. This home was over two years in the making from design to completion with over-the-top specs and extra touches that buyers will appreciate.

Starting with the foundation of the house, the owner went one (or two!) better than the FEMA requirement of finished floor elevation at 7 feet. This home's FFE is 9 feet. The pool deck is at the same elevation. The timeless exterior features a barrel-tile roof, stucco and stone walls and details like brackets and wide overhangs. A paver driveway, breezeway, steps, porch and pathway -8,000 square feet of pavers — surround the home.

The extra-high dock was constructed with 12-inch pilings, 40 feet long, handselected by the owner and driven down at least 20 feet. There is a 16,000-pound lift under roof (the owner's Grady White boat is 4,500 lbs.) plus a 6,000-pound lift on the side. The bulkhead is wood with rip rap in front. When they installed the

bulkhead, the permit allowed them to extend the property.

The pool has two swim shelves, three fountain jets and a state-of-the-art cleaning system. The screen enclosure was designed to preserve sight lines from any room of this home. This huge area includes access to utilities for future summer kitchen installation.

Inside, the open plan rules, featuring panoramic views from most areas of the house on both levels. Tones are earthy, allowing the inside and outside spaces to merge with little interruption through the beautiful PGT Low-E vinyl windows and doors. Tesoro wood plank-style tile flooring runs through most of the main level, which includes the owner's suite, guest suite, office, pool bath, formal dining area, great room and three storage areas. The kitchen features Thermador appliances and a 10-foot island with a seamless granite top.





### Mayport Shrimp, Snapper and Watermelon Ceviche (Serves 4)

- 6 ounces medium shrimp, peeled, deveined
- 6 ounces highest quality skinless snapper filet, cut into half-inch pieces
- 1 jalapeño, seeds removed and minced
- ½ cup fresh lime juice, plus more for garnishing
- ¼ cup fresh orange juice
- 2 cups fresh watermelon, cut into bite-sized cubes
- 1 avocado, halved and diced
- $\blacksquare$  ½ small red onion, very thinly sliced
- ½ cup fresh cilantro, coarsely chopped
- Tortilla chips, for serving

Cook shrimp in medium pot of boiling, salted water for 45 seconds, just until pink on outside, but barely cooked on inside. Transfer to an ice bath; drain and pat dry. Cut shrimp into half-inch pieces and transfer to large bowl. Add snapper, jalapeño, orange juice and lime juice; toss to combine. Chill, tossing occasionally, at least 20 minutes, but an hour is best. Add watermelon, onion, avocado and cilantro just before serving and toss. Season with salt to taste. NOTE: This recipe is also delicious with just shrimp, or if fresh snapper is not in season, grouper or corvina can be substituted. For this

recipe, I found the freshest Mayport shrimp and snapper at Dan's Seafood in Ponte Vedra.

### **Key Lime Pie Bars (Serves 10-12) Crust:**

- 1½ cups graham cracker crumbs (12 graham cracker sheets)
- 6 Tbsp. melted, Kerrygold butter
- 2 Tbsp. granulated sugar
- 1 tsp kosher salt

Pulse graham cracker sheets (in batches if needed) in food processor until fine crumbs. (Or purchase store-bought graham cracker crumbs to save a step.) Add sugar and salt, then drizzle in melted butter and mix well until crumbs are coated with butter. Line a half-size rimmed baking sheet with parchment paper. Press mixture into a quarter-inch crust to cover bottom (or double recipe for a full size baking sheet). Bake at 350°F for 10 minutes, just until slightly brown. Allow to cool completely before adding key lime mixture.

### **Key Lime Filling:**

- 1 14 oz. can Eagle Brand sweetened condensed milk
- $\blacksquare$  ½ cup fresh squeezed Key Lime juice (about one bag, or 8-10 key limes)
- 3 large egg yolks

Combine condensed milk, lime juice and egg yolks in bowl and mix thoroughly. Pour over cooled graham cracker crust and bake at 350°F for 10 minutes. Allow to cool before refrigerating. After refrigerating, cut into squares, or small two- to three-bite rectangles. Garnish with Cool Whip if desired. (Note: For crust, it is very important to use at least 82% fat butter to ensure the rich butter taste as well as crunch in the crust. Low-fat butter or substitutes will not produce the same crust.)


I'd like to share with you how I found my inspiration.

## Deter. Detect. Defend.

Every year, thousands of people are victims of identity theft. It can happen to anyone, even you and me! Therefore, I want to share with you a technique that I use for my finance to help protect me from bandits. One of the best weapons in the confrontation with identity theft is to put a "credit freeze" on your existing credit. It took me 15 minutes and

cost \$30 to establish a credit freeze with the three credit reporting companies (Experian, TransUnion and Equifax). However, as of September 2018, there is no charge to place or remove a credit freeze. This relatively easy procedure, without cost, makes this approach essentially a "no-brainer," as we can significantly lower the probability of having someone steal our identity. Below are the most common questions and answers regarding a credit freeze.

#### What is a credit freeze?

Most states have laws that allow consumers to "freeze" credit. In essence, access to credit reports is restricted. If a consumer places a credit freeze, potential creditors and other individuals will not be able to gain access to the credit report unless the freeze is temporarily "lifted." Having a credit freeze makes it very unlikely that an identity thief would be able to establish an account in your name.

## Who can access my credit report if I place a credit freeze?

Companies that we do business with will continue to have access to our credit report. In addition, some states, potential employers, insurance companies, property owners and other non-creditors can still get access to your credit report with a credit freeze in

#### What is the cost to establish a credit freeze?

There is no charge for placing, temporarily lifting and permanently removing a credit freeze.

## How do I place a credit freeze?

To place a credit freeze, you will need to contact the three nationwide credit bureaus — Equifax, Experian and TransUnion. Online, you will type in your name, address, social security number and date of birth. You can also submit a credit freeze via phone or in writing. You may have to give a previous address if you have lived at your current one for less than two years. In addition, you may need to answer a few questions about your background, including loans you have taken out, credit cards you hold or previous addresses to confirm your identity.

## How do I temporarily lift my credit freeze to give one access to my credit

If you want to apply for a loan or credit card, or need to give someone access to your credit report, temporarily lifting your credit freeze is easy. Each of the three consumer rating companies will give you a personal identification number. You will need your PIN to lift the credit freeze. You can do this online, by phone or mail.

Is a credit freeze for everyone?

No. Having a credit freeze can be inconvenient if you continually lift your credit freeze. When consumers request to lift the freeze by phone or online, the credit bureaus must take that action within 1 hour, but if consumers make these requests by mail, the agency must place or lift the freeze within three business days.

Joe Ridout, consumer services manager with the nonprofit consumer rights group Consumer Action, said it best, "I think for anyone who is extremely concerned about the prospect of identity theft, there is no better tool than a credit freeze."

## Local author releases new historical romance novel 'Beacon Beach'

Taffeta dresses, rocky coastlines, forlorn lighthouses and the constrained modesty of a passionate Victorian romance highlight local resident Maggie Fitzroy's new book, "Beacon Beach."

Set in 1886 in Cape May, New Jersey, the novel weaves the romance genre with historical fiction at a luxurious seaside resort called "White Caps." The main character, Jacy James, struggles with societal expectations, grieving for the loss of her fiancé at sea and her budding feelings for a convalescent residing at the resort, Cole Stratton. All making for one perfect summer read, to be consumed beachside with one's toes in the sand.

"Beacon Beach" marks Fitzroy's fourth novel and second fiction novel. A longtime journalist who made a career at First Coast Magazine and The Times Union's Shorelines, Fitzroy got her start writing at the Ponte Vedra Recorder in 1998, after leaving a job teaching at The Florida School for the Deaf and Blind.

"I felt I wasn't doing what I was supposed to be doing in life," Fitzroy said.

Self-taught, Fitzroy began with photography, taking pictures of community

events. Soon, she realized that pictures weren't telling the "whole story," so she asked for an opportunity at writing — which, ironically, was immediately shot down.

"He said, 'you can't write, photographers can't write, they can't even spell," she said.

Rather than letting one editor stand in the way of what she thought she could do, she kept asking until the then new Ponte Vedra Recorder editor, Grace Hayes,

came to the position and encouraged her to write and pursue her passions.

From there, Fitzroy taught herself journalism, interviewing members of the Ponte Vedra area and connecting people across the neighborhood. She became interested in the historical landscape of the communities she was in and learning to research and verify facts. After transitioning to the Times-Union and then First Coast Magazine, she found herself wondering what her next step would be. Luckily, her editor at the time doubted her less than she doubted herself.

"Why don't you write a novel?" she

Fitzroy didn't think she could, but she






