St. Johns County School District reports 141 student cases of COVID-19 on Aug. 17

As of Aug. 17, there were 141 cases of CO-VID-19 in the St. Johns County School District student population, and 69 positive cases with St. Johns County School District employees. There were also 221 St. Johns County school students in quarantine and 34 employees, according to the school district's daily COVID update. There were five students and one employee who tested positive at Ponte Vedra High School as of Aug. 17, and seven students at Nease High School who were reported positive. Valley Ridge Academy reported six positive student cases and one employee case.

The total number of COVID-positive students and total number of quarantined students shown in the update are based upon reporting from parents/guardians.

High School Essay Contest celebrates Bill of Rights

The lawyers and judges of the United States District Court, Middle District of Florida and the members of the Jacksonville Chapter of the Federal Bar Association announced the launch of the 2021 High School Essay Contest commemorating the 230th anniversary of the ratification of the Bill of Rights,

The contest is open to students currently in grades 10 through 12 in counties in the Jacksonville Division of the Middle District of Florida (Baker, Bradford, Clay, Columbia, Duval, Flagler, Hamilton, Nassau, Putnam, St. Johns, Suwannee and Union).

The personal freedoms we cherish as citizens of the United States are set forth in, and protected by, the first 10 amendments to the United States Constitution. Known as the Bill of Rights, these amendments have shaped our democracy for 230 years. The 2021 Essay Contest prompt asks students to select the amendment most important to students attending public schools, and





County Commission gives nod to proposed tax rate

On Aug. 3, St. Johns County Commissioners unanimously set the proposed tax rate for FY 2022 at \$6.8147 per \$1,000 of taxable value. This represents a marginal increase over this year's rate of \$6.813.

The proposed rate is not necessarily the final rate. However, once set, the county

cannot reasonably increase it. The rate can, however, be reduced during one of the two public hearings to be held in September.

Because the county has seen a 9.27% increase in property values since last year, the county can expect to see a \$19 million increase in tax revenue next year. These

increases have helped moderate the need for any tax increases.

The total budget is \$1.1 billion.

This year's rolled-back rate is \$6.53. The rolled-back rate is the rate that would generate the same revenue as last year, dollar-for-dollar.

Under the proposed rate, the owner of a \$400,000 home with a homestead exemption could expect a tax bill of about \$2,400.

The board also set the time and date of the first public hearing. It will be held at 5:01 p.m. Sept. 7.

United States Courthouse in Jacksonville.

given the opportunity to shadow a federal

judge for a day.

Flagler Health+ contributes to COVID-19 testing site

City of St. Augustine, Ivy Medical join partnership to open facility at St. Augustine Visitor Information Center

Flagler Health+ announced, in partnership with the City of St. Augustine and Ivy Medical, a COVID-19 testing site opened on Monday, Aug. 16, to service the needs of the St. Augustine and surrounding communities with both PCR and Rapid Antigen tests available.

The COVID-19 testing site is located at the bus loop of the city's Visitor Information Center at 10 S. Castillo Drive. Beginning Monday, the site will be open Monday through Friday, 8:30 a.m. until 1:30 p.m. "We know that fast and easy access to COVID-19 testing is an important component to stopping the spread of the virus and supporting area businesses' ability to safely remain open," stated Flagler Health+ President & CEO Jason Barrett. "I commend City of St. Augustine leadership for supporting this initiative with the location and support services."

Flagler Health+ will provide the testing through a partnership with Ivy Medical, offering Antigen Rapid Test and the rt-PCR Tests. The Antigen Rapid Test provides results within two hours from individuals suspected of having COVID-19 within five days of symptom onset. The PCR Test gives results within two business days and identifies an active infection, regardless of whether the infection is early stage, late stage, or anywhere in between.

"With the increased cases of COVID and the related demand for testing, we feel that it is critical to offer a convenient, safe alternative to get a COVID test," City Manager John Regan said. "We must do whatever it takes to help offset the burden of COVID testing on our local healthcare system so they can stay focused on providing necessary care to the sick."

Testing is available for all ages, but a parent or guardian must be present for children under 18 to be tested. Insurance is accepted and self-pay is available.

Patients must pre-register for their test by downloading the Flagler Health+ Anywhere app or going to the Flagler Health Anywhere website. To schedule a test, log onto the app and use the "Get Care" function, select the St. Augustine COVID-19 testing option and follow the prompts. Fire Watch aims to prevent veteran suicide once and for all

The Fire Watch is taking a unique approach in the fight against veteran suicide and the community is a big part of it.

It uses a grassroots program that uses community members known as "watch standers" to prevent veteran suicide instead of treating it.

"We're doing something unique," The Fire Watch Executive Director Nick Howland said. "For the last 10 years, the attempted solution has been treatment, which the VA has put billions of dollars into. Our goal is focused on prevention and not allowing it to get to the point where you need treatment."

The nonprofit organization began in 2019 after receiving support from the county commissions within its five-county coverage area, that includes St. Johns, Duval, Clay, Baker, and Nassau counties.

"It was created by an interlocked agreement by county commissioners," Howland said.

In 2018, 6,435 veterans committed suicide in the United States, 577 in Florida and 61 in Northeast Florida.

However, that number increased to 78

in Northeast Florida in 2019, which is equivalent to losing more than one veteran a week to suicide locally. The 2020 numbers were not yet available.

There are more than 150,000 veterans in Northeast Florida, according to The Fire Watch website.

According to Howland, the watch standers idea was based off the CPR initiative that came into effect in the '70s and '80s and had a role in lessening the number of people dying from heart-related problems.

"This doesn't make people experts, but it makes them more aware of the signs than they were before," Howland said. "It's all about getting veterans to solutions early."

By the community understanding the warning signs of veteran suicide and what to do to get help when spotted, it creates a wider safety net that veterans can rely on.

Those warning signs can be prompted by many types of stress in one's life, including that related to financial, physical or the mental distress veterans encounter after returning home from tours of duty.

Howland acknowledged that it can be difficult to ask for help on one's own, but

when someone is there to talk to about it, asking for help can become much easier.

"Many suicide survivors will tell you that even if one person came up to them, they would not have attempted it," Howland said.

Since the watch standers program was launched in May 2020, it has continued to grow to about 1,300 current members.

"We're getting such great support from everyone in our community, from the residents to the county leaders," Howland said. "It doesn't matter what side of the political aisle you are on, it is a cause you can get behind."

According to Howland, the amount of success the program has showed in Northeast Florida has caught the eye of state leaders and there is a plan in place to expand the watch standers initiative to a statewide level once the necessary funding is sorted out.

"Everyone wants to do more than just thank a veteran, and this is a way to give back," Howland said. "If they come across a veteran showing signs, they can talk to them and get them the resources they need for help." is simple and something that Howland encourages anybody to consider.

Becoming a watch stander is free and requires visiting www.thefirewatch. org/watch-standers and watching 30- to 45-minutes of informational video.

"We don't want money to be a barrier that keeps people from helping," Howland said. "There's a role for everybody to play."

One of the biggest recent advancements for The Fire Watch is the ability to obtain acquisition of census-level data, which they use to see where the hot spots are in Northeast Florida to have a better understanding of where they need to focus their attention on getting more watch standers. "For the last 20 years, the only one

collecting data was the VA, and they only collected it at the state level," Howland said. "We've gotten together with NLP Logix and the Florida Department of Health to begin collecting our own data. It's a leap forward in effectiveness."

You've been praised for how you steered the Jacksonville store through the pandemic. Tell me about that.

It's a very coworker-centric company. They always look to take care of the coworkers, so that's one nice thing. We knew the company would be there for us.

We were closed for almost three months, and then we opened. Ever since then it's been OK, but those three months we were closed, it was a very difficult time.

We did end up furloughing a portion of our coworkers. It ended up being a few weeks. The company did pay the coworkers the full amount for quite a while, and then we ended up furloughing.

Probably a month before we actually opened to the public, we started doing online orders out of the store. So, we were able to bring some coworkers back fairly quickly.

Then we opened up the store and called everybody back.

This is IKEA's busiest time of the year. It comes at a time when a lot of retail stores are finding it difficult to get stock due to recent disruptions in supply chains. How are you meeting this challenge?

This is probably the most difficult one right now. We're a global company. We have a lot of global supply. And the pandemic has been hitting different areas of the globe in different ways.

The good news for us is we have 95- to 100-plus articles here, so while we might be out of some things, we have other, alternative items in stock.

It's improved over time, and we're looking forward to it continuing to improve.

Like any other business, you try to take care of the customer in the best way possible.

IKEA has made a commitment to sustainability. Tell me what your store is doing.

This is one of the things we're most excited about. My company has been at the forefront of sustainability. We were talking about it back in 2001.

We have solar panels covering a majority of our roof. It's a large building; I think we have 5,400-plus solar panels on our roof. The cool thing is, it allows us to generate our own energy, and what we overgenerate we can actually put back in the JEA grid. We've been measuring our diversion rate, our trash, for years. Last year, we diverted almost 70% of our waste away from landfills.

And then our products. We're developing more sustainable products all the time.

There's one other thing I want to mention. We have a very busy restaurant here, and we are looking at 50 percent of the restaurant meals being plant-based by 2025.


We're looking at doing our part. I think our overall goal is to be climate-positive by 2030.

How does your role as the store's market manager help you make a positive impact on the community?

This is as big of a thing for us as sustainability. For years we were called store managers. And they changed it recently to market manager, because the way people shop, our interactions with the community, and everything else is changing.

We want to be a long-term part of the community, so we have a lot of initiatives and actions that we take.

We donate a lot of time. We do beach clean-ups. We have all kinds of projects that we're working on. We were working with some local high schools where we donated products to help them with their athletic safety.



We have partnerships. We just did a partnership that's really cool with the Alhambra Theater. And we've worked with Sulzbacher here locally.

We want to do even more in the community.

That is such a big thing for us, and it's a big thing personally. I really want IKEA to be part of the local community. That's something that's so important to us here in Jacksonville. You have corporate teams that just come in and open a chain here or a big box retailer there. That's one thing that kind of separates us: We really, really reach out and want to be part of the community. We've only been here three years, so in IKEA terms, it's new, but over time we want to be in the fabric of the community.

Tell me about your background.

Before I was with IKEA, I came from a more corporate finance background. I worked for a bunch of large firms. And I just wanted a change of pace. I started working 20 years ago at the corporate office in Philadelphia for IKEA.

They wanted me to go out for a couple of years and get some experience in the store. I went to Dallas to

open the first store there. I lived in Fort Lauderdale, Charlotte and now Jacksonville, all working at IKEA stores. And I enjoy it, so, I kind of never went back.

How long have you lived in Ponte Vedra?

We've been here about two and a half years.

What do you like best about living in this area?

Ponte Vedra is a beach community, but it doesn't feel busy or crowded or hectic like all the other ones I've lived in. I like that it's relaxed. I think for a beach area, it's very aesthetically nice, it's beautiful.

I like golfing, too.

There's a good feeling of community here, too, so I enjoy that.

What do you like to do in your free time?

Golf would be one. My youngest son plays lacrosse at Ponte Vedra High School so we go to a lot of lacrosse games and outings and stuff like that. Just spending time with my family.

We really like living here. It's where we'd like to stay.

a bit of stunning ambience for your trouble. Climbing, flowering vines can provide such a unique touch to any garden or landscape. They're textured, colorful, and can often grow in unusual places. They can act as a natural accent wall to your outdoor space, provide some welcome privacy, and spruce up any empty space, including bare walls and fences.

Climbing plants can give your yard an organic and inviting feel, and add beautiful ambience.

What are some of the best flowering vines for Northeast Florida?

Here are some of the beautiful climbers we carry at the Nursery:

Allamanda: Fastest growing vine with bright yellow blooms. Great vine to have around a patio or pool, but be careful;



their seeds are poisonous to humans and animals.

Bougainvillea: This vine is a tropical plant that loves Florida heat and requires full sun to create such vibrant blooms. They will bloom most of the year right up until winter in our zone and climes quickly.

Bleeding heart: Another tropical vine that thrives with full shade or morning sun. This vine has dark green leaves and clusters of red and white flowers that can be pruned into the shape of your choice.

Carolina jasmine: This vine has a fragrant, yellow bloom and can grow to 25 feet. They bloom in late winter/early spring

and thrive in this zone, as long as we don't have a harsh winter.

Mandevilla: Loves the Florida heat, but needs some shade in the hottest part of the day. Also an easy grower, this vine comes in a variety of bright colors.


Confederate jasmine: Easy grower in partial-to-full sun. They grow to be at least 6-feet long and bloom a small white flower each May.

Earth Fare's resurgence leads to round 2 in St. Johns County

Earth Fare is back in St. Johns County as they continued their comeback story following a tumultuous couple of years with a ribbon cutting ceremony

for its new location at 120 Shops Blvd. in St. Johns.

The height of the tough times included Earth Fare filing for bankruptcy in February 2020 and having to close many of its locations, which included

the one in St. Johns County that had only been open for six months.

"A group of local Earth Fare advocates got together along with one of

Buyers forced to sidelines as housing prices continue to climb

Many would-be buyers are being priced out of the market as sales prices in Northeast Florida continue to climb.

In July, the median sales price on properties in the region rose 15% from a year ago to \$303,600. The average sales price of \$381,499 for residential real estate also was 18.4% higher than a year ago. And 45.6% of all properties sold for more than their asking price, an astronomical increase of 190.4% since July 2020 when the percentage was only 15.7. Meanwhile, Realtors cheered as new listings showed a 6.9% increase over the past year to 3,915 units

"While the number of new listings increased compared to the same time last year, the continued demand for homes in Northeast Florida remained strong, bringing little relief to those still in the market to buy," explained Missi Howell, president of the Northeast Florida Association of Realtors. "The increase in sales prices is far outpacing wages, and with almost 50%

of homes being sold over the sellers' asking prices, first-time homebuyers continue to struggle with their dream of homeownership and move-up buyers hesitate to list their homes due to concerns of what will be available for them to buy."

There was an ever-so-slight increase since June bringing Northeast Florida's housing inventory to 4,668 units, but this still represents a 40.6% drop from July 2020. The number of homes for sale continued to hover at a historic low of

1.4 months' supply, and pending sales dropped 10.6% to 3,287 from a year ago and with most properties averaging 33 days on the market before sale.

"Pending sales of previously owned homes nudged out new construction by a nose, perhaps indicating that the rapid cost increases driven by material costs are losing favor with buyers," Howell said.



to six months' worth of your take-home pay available and accessible to cover expenses in the event of a job loss or a medical emergency.

More families abandoning health insurance for monthly medical memberships

With health care costs on the rise, a growing number of Americans are throwing out the old way of seeing a doctor and turning to a membership model. A monthly or annual fee gets you direct access to a doctor, no insurance needed.

Patients can meet with the DPC doctor at the clinic or consult with him or her through email. Healthcare happens outside the office as well as inside, and patients with quick questions can simply avoid the drive to the office and speak to their DPC doctor on the phone or even email them.

Florida real estate has become increasingly less affordable. In July, Northeast Florida's affordability index mirrored that of June at 118. This represents an 11.9% drop from July 2020, when the index stood at 134. An index of 118 means that the median household income was 118% of what is necessary to qualify for the median-priced home under prevailing interest rates. The higher the index the more affordable housing is in the region.

REVIEW 'Sound of Music' debuts at Alhambra

One of musical theatre's most beloved shows returned to Jacksonville last week, when The Alhambra Theatre & Dining debuted its new production of Rodgers & Hammerstein's "The Sound of Music."

For anyone under the age of 60, the name "The Sound of Music" likely conjures up images of the Academy Award-winning film starring Julie Andrews. 

Lindsey Buckingham, one of the most inventive and electrifying musicians of his generation, will take the stage at Ponte Vedra Concert Hall on Sept. 26.

tion and an unrivaled savvy as a producer, skills he first honed as a singer, guitarist, songwriter, producer and the musical visionary of Fleetwood Mac, where he wrote and produced several Top Ten hits, including "Go Your Own Way" and "Big Love."

Under Buckingham's direction, Fleetwood Mac became one of the best-selling and most beloved rock groups of all time.

As a solo artist, Buckingham often plays nearly every instrument himself. Earlier this year, he appeared on "Caution," the newest single from the Killers. He remains a highly sought-after collaborator, a maverick and a visionary.

teen" and "Climb Every Mountain." One of the major changes in the stage version, however, is the presentation of the characters of scheming music promoter Max Detwiler (Jay Goldberg) and Baroness Elsa von Schraeder (Jennifer Medure), a wealthy socialite with her sights set on landing the captain as her husband. Whereas in the film these characters have a more serious presentation, the stage duo comes across more like a 1930s version of Jack and Karen from "Will and Grace" as they perform two musical numbers. In "How Can Love Survive," Max and Elsa jokingly ponder whether wealthy people can have a successful relationship. And in "No Way to Stop It," the pragmatic pair try to convince the idealistic captain to stop fretting about those pesky Nazis and just accept the situation. Given the coming war, however, the jaunty, comedic tone of these numbers seems a bit callous. which may explain their absence from






